A semi-autobiographical book about the troubles of life and growing up in Nottingham.

This book is very cringe-worthy. It is told in a light-hearted way about the trials and tribulations of Belle, a twenty-something smart, intelligent girl, who because of a poor choice, sees her life spiralling out of control. This would be fine on its own if the troubles she had were simply her first marriage. However, physical abuse, unplanned gynaecological operations and the death of a baby are not really things to look at with amusement.

The story would have been better if written differently, but I am sorry, I found it very distasteful. Especially as the author has herself experienced most of Belle's troubles.
